Tech Night at Porsche Monmouth 3/18/26

On March 18th, Porsche Monmouth hosted a Tech Night for Jersey Shore Region members. In addition to providing a tour of their redesigned state of the art Service Center, the featured guest speaker was Tom Misciagna, Area East Trainer for Porsche Cars North America. Tom was a wealth of knowledge and covered many topics on what is new with Porsche.

To the delight of the engineers and technical weenies in attendance, Tom got pretty deep into the weeds when explaining the innovations that have gone into the internal combustion engines. He also described how the electric motors in the new hybrid 911's are incorporated in the drivetrain to produce extraordinary amounts of horsepower and torque.

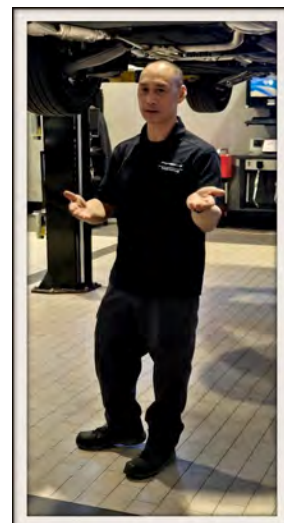
Even for those not as technically inclined, it was a very informative and engaging presentation. Patrick and Tom happily fielded questions from the group and were available to talk with members afterwards who wanted to learn more.

The EV battery section was an especially interesting part of the Service Area tour. Cars may be partially built by robots, but it takes highly skilled people who are passionate about what they do to maintain and repair them. Included in the battery talk was how the technicians had to wear protective suits, gloves, and helmets at various times to safely handle the batteries. Also, how testing checks each battery pack (there are many per "engine") to make sure they all are matched power wise.

Amazon Fulfillment Center Tour 3/18/26 - Brian O'Sullivan

After lunch at True Food Kitchen on Route 1 in Edison, the group headed out to the day's main event. The tour of the Amazon Fulfillment Center LGA9 offered an inside look at the scale and precision of modern logistics. Upon arrival, the vast facility immediately stood out, with its organized layout and constant motion of goods and workers. The tour highlighted how products move seamlessly from receiving to storage, picking, packing, and shipping, all coordinated through advanced technology and tracking systems. Robotics played a major role, with mobile units transporting shelves to employees, significantly increasing efficiency and reducing physical strain.

Employees demonstrated each step of the process, explaining how orders are processed accurately, even during peak demand. Safety measures and workflow optimization were emphasized throughout the visit, showing how the facility balances speed with worker well-being. Overall, the experience provided a clear understanding of how Amazon fulfills millions of orders daily, blending human effort with automation to deliver packages quickly and reliably.

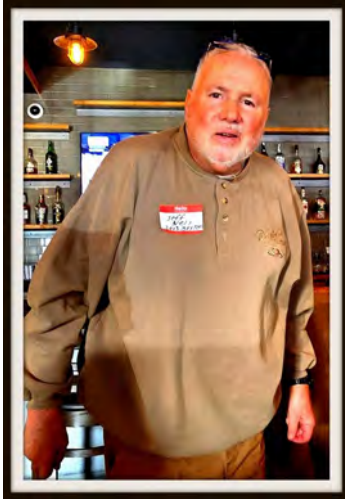
Jersey Shore Region Annual Rolex 24 of Daytona Viewing & New Member Meeting! January 26th

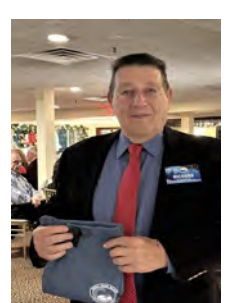

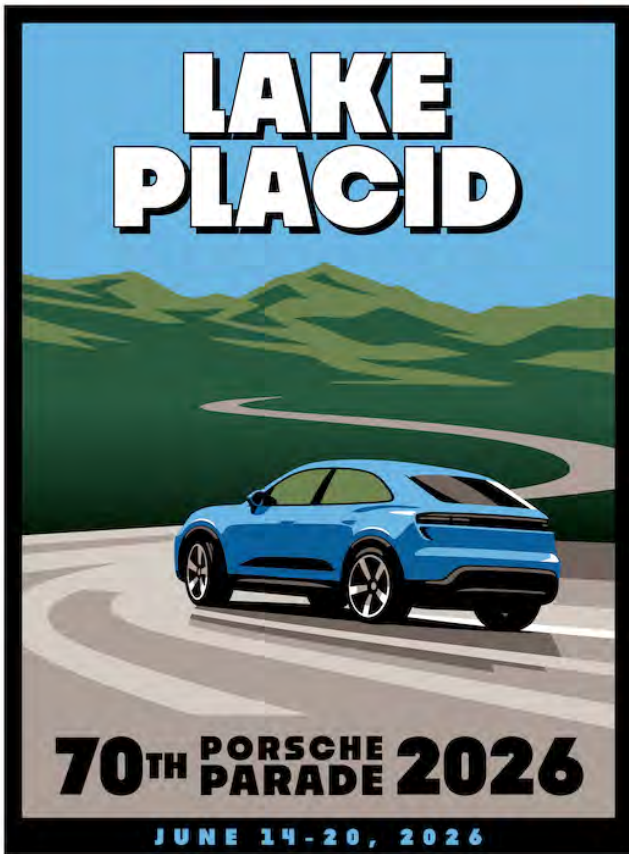
